The themes of the 9ICAANE connect Near Eastern Archaeology, to Prehistoric, Egyptian, and Classical archaeology, allowing us to extend the invitation to participate to scholars of many different specialties, who actively pursue research on the cultures of the Ancient Near East.

General

- **All speakers are requested to observe a 20 minutes limit for their papers.**
- All speakers must be registered in the congress.
- No papers or posters dealing with unprovenanced artefacts will be accepted.
- Abstracts submitted for papers, posters, workshops should be no longer than 200 words.
- All submitted abstracts will be evaluated by the Organizing Committee. Information on accepted proposals will be sent via e-mail.
- The abstracts of the accepted papers, workshops, and posters will be published on our website by February 2014.
- Congress languages are English, German, French, and Italian.

Themes

Special consideration will be given to the following themes:

1. Egypt and Ancient Near East – Perceptions of Alterity
2. Travelling Images – Transfer and Transformation of Visual Ideas
3. Ancient Near Eastern Traditions vs. Hellenization/ Romanization
4. Reconstructing Ancient Eco-Systems
5. Dealing with the Past: Finds, booty, gifts, spoils, heirlooms
6. Excavation Reports and Summaries in Near Eastern and Islamic Archaeology

Posters

- **At least one author of a poster has to register (including payment) for the congress.**
- Any kind of work in progress related to Near Eastern Archaeology will be considered.
- Accepted poster format is up to A0.
- Posters can be displayed from Monday lunchtime and should be taken down on Friday morning.
- There will be a special poster session on Tuesday afternoon when you should stand next to your posters so that you can discuss your work with other congress delegates.

Workshops

- **There will be no more than 8 workshops.**
- **The theme of the workshop should be clearly different from the general themes of the 9ICAANE.**
- Persons wishing to organize a workshop are invited to propose themes to the Organizers by email.
- Proponents must provide at least 6, maximum 9 active participants for each workshop.
