

## **ICAANE Publication of Papers**

**Dear Colleagues** 

The 9th International Congress on the Archaeology of the Ancient Near East (ICAANE), Basel (Switzerland) is over. The Basel Organizing Committee thanks all the participants for their contributions.

The next step is the publication of the Proceedings of the 9th ICAANE.

The Proceedings of the 9<sup>th</sup> ICAANE wil be published by **Harrassowitz Verlag**. As with the previous ICAANE volumes (cf. 2008 Rome, 2010 London, 2012 Warsaw) there will be **three volumes**, with a **maximum of about 2700 pages**. They have to be printed in the beginning of 2016, to be available at the 10<sup>th</sup> ICAANE 2016 in Vienna.

This imposes several restrictions regarding the number and size of papers for our publication, which we will have to implement very strictly. The most important are:

- 1. Only **papers that have been presented in Basel** will be considered.
- 2. **Please do follow our guidelines**. It saves time and trouble for everybody.
- 3. The **deadline** is:

## **Guidelines**

## Papers (sections, posters, workshops)

#### Text

**Office Word compatible, maximum 4000 words** (including bibliography, footnotes, captions, summary, etc.).

- *First page*: Title of the paper, name of author, affiliation, english abstract (max. 50 words)
- Last page (after bibliography): Captions for the images  $\rightarrow$  Fig. 1 texttext
- References to figures within the text in brackets → texttext (fig. 1).
- Chapter Headings hierarchy. Maximum two hierarchic levels. E.g. HEADING 1., heading 1.1.

Please, no images in the Office Word document! Send them as separate files!

Font: **Times**, **11 pt**. Please, limit (special) formatting to a strict minimum.

**PDF to countercheck** (in case there are any problems with the fonts of the text)

Images/Figures (as separate files)

maximum 8 images (e.g. 8 images of max. half a A5-page, or 4 images full-page).

All B &W, grey. Only Tiff & Jpeg. Line drawings: 600 dpi. Photos: 300 dpi.

### **Citation (as in former ICAANE publications)**

Author & Year in brackets in text, respectively in footnotes

→ texttext (Weiss 1990: 92; Stronach 1994: fig. 5; Nashef 1982: pl. 1).

## The Procedure – Step by Step

Here some information, how the steps to publication are scheduled:

### **Theme-Sections & Posters**

Step	Date (by)		
1	<b>2014</b> December 31	Deadline	Afterwards the editors will check if the guidelines are respected (see above)  If yes, then Step 2. If not, the paper will not be accepted.
2	<b>2015</b> March 31	Evaluation	The papers are <b>evaluated by the organizers</b> of the respective sections.
3	October 31	Layout	The papers will be set in layout and paginated.
4	November 30	Corrections	The papers will be sent to the author(s) as a PDF for <b>proof reading</b> . Only typos and minimal changes will be considered.
5	<b>2016</b> January 31	Print	The Proceedings will go to print

### Workshops

The organizers of the workshops should let us know as soon as possible, if they plan a publication within the 9ICAANE-proceedings. If you publish the workshop separately, please, provide a reference that the workshop was held during the 9ICAANE in Basel.

- Workshops published within the proceedings of the congress will form an own, separate section, if they comprise 5 or more papers. If there are less papers, they will be published in one of the main sections (with a reference to the workshop).
- For papers presented in a workshop the first two steps "Deadline" and "Evaluation" will be settled by the organisers of the respective workshops. They will collect the papers and evaluate them.
- The organizers should send us the texts of all papers as one single Word document providing the correct sequence.

### **For Authors**

- A PDF of their papers will be made available to the authors.
- The whole proceedings can be ordered at Harrassowitz Verlag at a reduced price.
